The Trust has just held its first AGM and is on a solid footing in terms of having all the establishment phase complete. We have a registered Charitable Trust, and the support of appropriate professionals to enable us to run it in a transparent and auditable fashion.

We would like to express our gratitude for the support of a Papakura based Accounting practice, Natrass Gibb & Associates, to ensure we are following proper accounting practices.

Our thanks go to Glenn Archibald who was our original Accountant, and who is retiring, having transitioned his practice into the hands of his skilled associates. We'd like to thank Penny and Wendy, who have taken over the practice, and renamed it from Archibald and Associates to Natrass Gibb & Associates. They have recently commenced under the new brand.

Much of the last year has flown by, while we got onto a sound structure for running the Trust. We have met with potential donors, clubs and organisations and have been successful in a small way in raising donations and sponsorships of \$20k (in round numbers). However our ambition is to be able to supply the school with a significantly larger amount each year, and we are asking you, as interested supporters of the school to see if you can find ways to donate via fundraising, a regular weekly or monthly donation out of your bank account to ours, or via corporate or club sponsorships or grants.

You are welcome to distribute our brochure to anyone you think may be willing to assist the Trustees, in our fundraising.

We encourage you to keep up with the school via its Facebook page and website and celebrate the progress it is showing in better outcomes for students academically and in transition to further study and to the workplace.

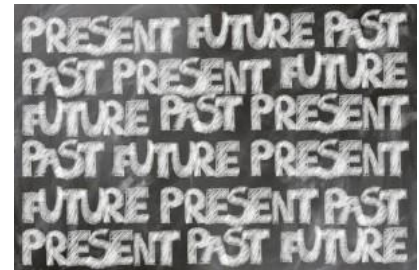
