Moving to Covid-19 Alert Level 2

Dear parents/caregivers,

Great news, whānau! The latest community outbreak of Covid-19 has been contained and we will all be able to return to school tomorrow.

Please note that school will be taking a number of measures to ensure the health and safety of all of our students and staff. A letter outlining these precautions will be emailed to you tonight. You can be assured that we will be taking this very seriously. While masks are not compulsory under Level 2, we would welcome any student who wishes to wear one for their peace of mind. We do ask that whānau do not come onto the school site under Level 2.

I have been informed that there is some misinformation circulating about a positive Covid case in the school. This is not true and I strongly encourage you not to believe or spread information that has not been confirmed by the school or health authorities. You can be assured that if there was a link to the school you would be notified.

At the beginning of the school day tomorrow we will be having a short Kaitohutohu time that is outside of our normal timetable. Please ask your rangatahi to go straight to their Kaitohutohu class. During this time we will be checking in on our students and gathering information around their access to devices at home as we do have some gaps. This will help us to be well-prepared should there be another alert level change in the future.

Again, we are very excited to be welcoming our rangatahi back to school tomorrow and hope that you will trust us to take good care of them.
