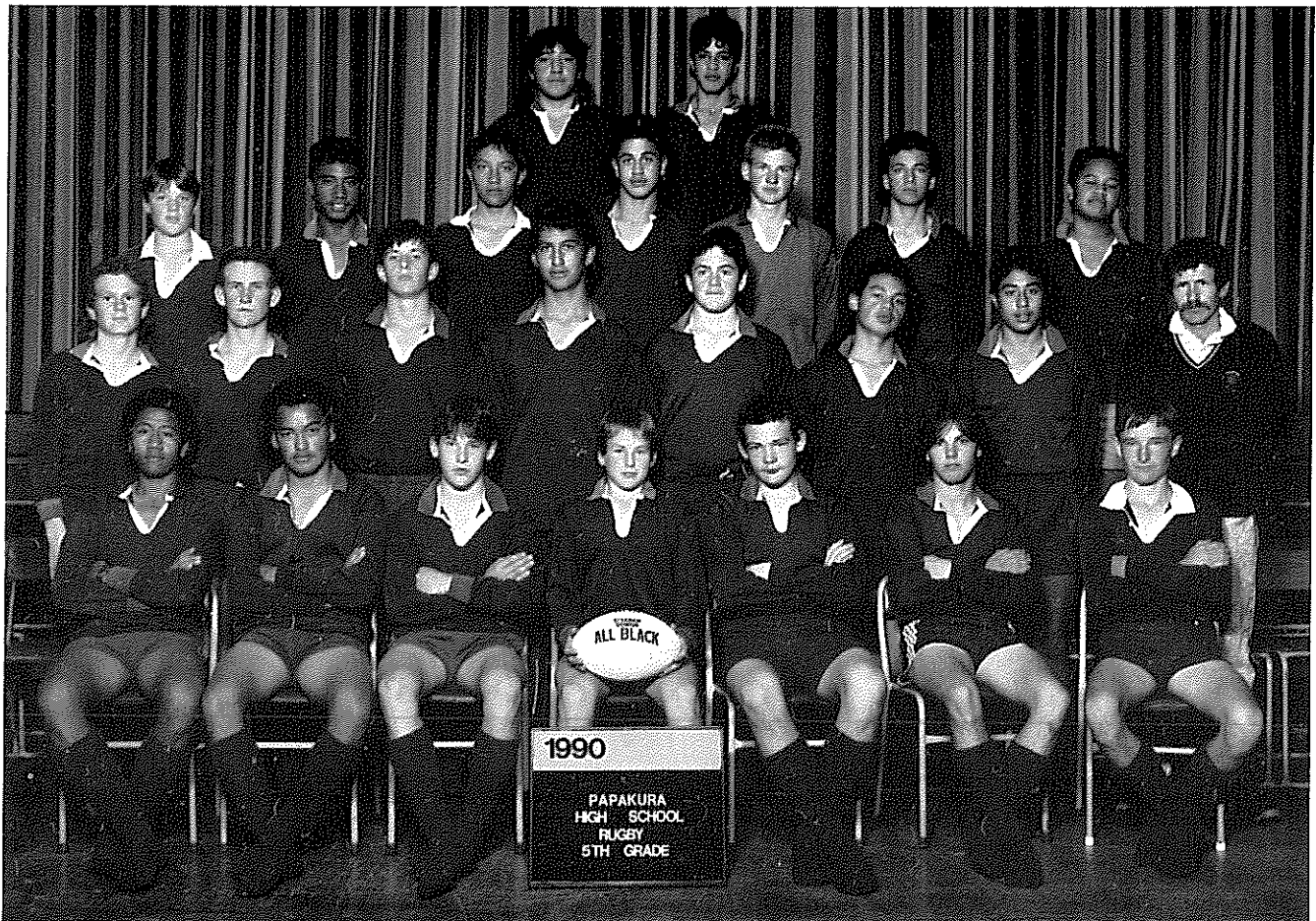
The 6th grade started the season successfully, beating St. Stephens B team and continued the season with excellent results.

Well the B Team succeeded but after bad cross country rounds the A Team was left out of the placings but the B Team moved up to fifth place.

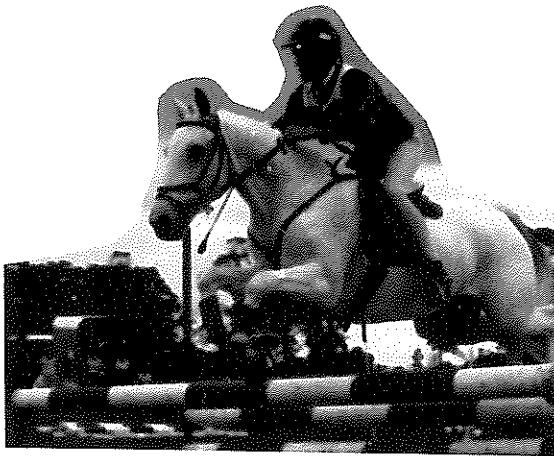
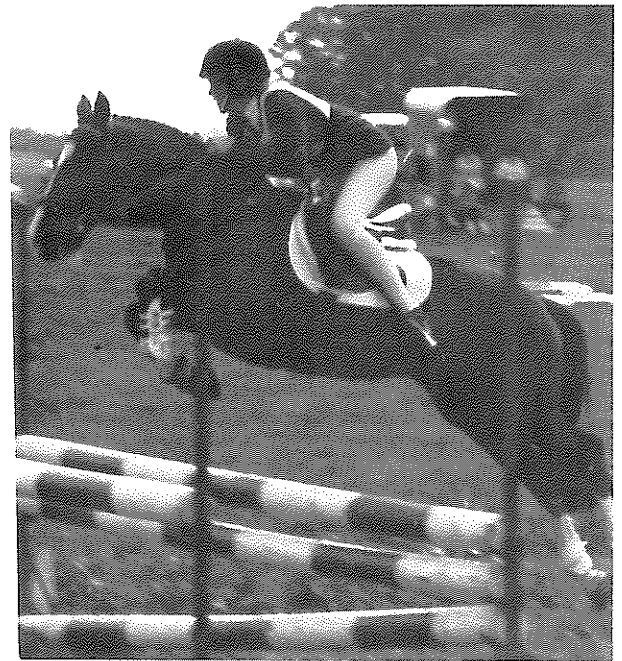

P.H.S. Welcomes New Students

The Intellectually Handicapped Students Unit was officially opened by the Right Hon. Merv Wellington, M.P. for Papakura on the 28th of March 1990. Mr Wellington planted a tree by the unit's entrance to commemorate this happy occasion.

Since the opening of the unit, the seven students enrolled have all benefited greatly from being included in the school life and activities of Papakura High School.

Once a week, some of the students attend a factory for work experience. There is also a community helper programme on Wednesday mornings during which helpers use their expertise to help extend the children on a one-to-one basis. Subjects taught in this programme include sewing, gardening, kitchen skills, industrial assembly, upholstery, elementary electrical assembly skills, computer studies, and shop-keeping.

Students from other classes are also supportive with regular peer-tutoring for the children. They assist the children with their studies, and encourage them to participate in physical games.

Apart from these activities, the children are taught subjects from the High School curriculum including horticulture, science, art, home-economics, living skills, physical education, and computer studies. Three periods a week they have a Special Studies programme that involves an Individual Education approach. This programme requires special equipment and planning.

The children have already commenced fitness training for a big event to be hosted by the unit. This occasion, which is a first for Secondary Special Needs pupils, is a mile race to be held at the Massey Park Papakura Stadium on November the 13th.
