Re: Year Levels Rostering Home

Due to the ongoing increase in Covid-19 cases in the community, larger numbers of staff have been identified as close contacts of positive cases. This means that it is continuing to be very difficult to ensure that the school has adequate staffing to cover all classes.

As a result, we have made the decision to continue rostering year levels home for the following two weeks. This will be reviewed on a weekly basis.

Work will be available for students on their teachers' google sites to continue on with. Students will be expected to continue their learning at home on these days.

The following year levels will be rostered home as below:

- **Tuesday 1 March - Year 11s**
- **Wednesday 2 March - Years 12 & 13**
- **Thursday 3 March - Year 9**
- **Friday 4 March - Year 10**


- **Monday 7 March - Year 11**

- **Wednesday 9 March - Year 9**
- **Thursday 10 March - Year 10**
- **Friday 11 March - Year 11**

We are able to provide supervision for students in Year 9 only who are not able to remain at home on the days they are rostered home. Please let the school know if you need your child to come to school on these days.

On days that students are not rostered home, they are expected to be at school unless directed to remain home by individually sent texts and/or emails.
