Re: Year Levels Rostering Home

Although case numbers of Covid in the community are slowly decreasing, we still have a number of staff absent due to having been identified as close contacts of positive cases. This means that it will still be very difficult to ensure that the school has adequate staffing to cover all classes next week.

This will be reviewed again at the end of next week.

Work will be available for students on their teachers' google sites to continue on with. Students will be expected to continue their learning at home on the days they are rostered home.

The following year levels will be rostered home as below:

- **Monday 14 March - Years 12 & 13**
- **Tuesday 15 March - Year 9**
- **Wednesday 16 March - Year 10**
- **Thursday 17 March - Year 11**
- **Friday 18 March - Years 12 & 13**

We are able to provide supervision for students in Year 9 only who are not able to remain at home on the days they are rostered home. Please let the school know if you need your child to come to school on these days.

On days that students are not rostered home, they are expected to be at school unless directed to remain home by individually sent texts and/or emails.
