PPTA Industrial Action

Warm greetings,

I am writing to inform you of the latest industrial action confirmed by the PPTA (secondary teachers' union) in support of their claim.

- Continuation of the ban on relief
- A ban on meetings outside of normal working hours (8.20 am - 4.20 pm). These include; student conferences, open evenings etc.
- Rostering home of allocated years levels from Monday - Thursday over the next three weeks

Dates for students rostering home are as follows:

Next week - Week 8

- Monday 12 June - Years 11 and 12
- Tuesday 13 June - Years 9 and 13
- Wednesday 14 June - Years 10 and 11
- Thursday 15 June - Years 12 and 13

Week 9

- Monday 19 June - Years 10 and 11
- Tuesday 20 June - Years 11 and 12
- Wednesday 21 June - Years 9 and 13
- Thursday 22 June - Years 10 and 11


Week 10

- Monday 26 June - Years 12 and 13
- Tuesday 27 June - Years 9 and 10
- Wednesday 28 June - Years 11 and 12
- Thursday 29 June - Years 9 and 13

We realise that this causes significant disruption to students' learning and remind our families that learning activities are available online through our website under the curriculum tab. Should the Ministry of Education and the PPTA reach a settlement then the above unconfirmed actions may not take place. All of our staff hope that this is able to happen quickly so that we can fully focus on getting on with learning.

Please be aware that this is out of the school's control and is happening across the country in all state secondary schools.
