

Senior Options

There are 4 options in Semester 1 and 4 in Semester 2.

Year 11

- 1. You must have a science, maths and a literacy subject during the year.
- 2. You will be working towards achieving Literacy and Numeracy this year plus 20 Level 2 credits.

Year 12

- 1. If you do not have Level 1 Numeracy you have been placed in 2Num or another maths class.
- 2. If you do not have Level 1 Literacy make sure you have selected an English class.
- 3. If you are going to university make sure you have at least one subject that offers UE literacy credits check on NZQA. You can only get UE writing in English.

Year 13


- 1. If you do not have Level 1 Numeracy you have been placed in 2Num or another maths class.
- 2. If you do not have Level 1 Literacy make sure you have selected an English class.

If you are going to University make sure;

- You have subjects to achieve UE literacy if you haven't already achieved it check on NZQA
- 2. You have 3 UE approved subjects for 2 semesters. These may both be in the same semester or in different semesters.

Incomplete Timetable


If you have gaps in your timetable, or you have concerns about the points outlined above you must come to school to get it sorted out. We will be in the Allen Kukutai Room.

2025 Timetable

When you look at your timetable you will see Day 1 to Day 5 (called Week A);



next week will show Day 6 to Day 10 (called Week B);



What's Different Between Week A and Week B?

- Some subjects or activities might happen in Week A but not Week B, or at different times.
- For example, you might have PE on Monday in Week A and on Thursday?in Week B.

Times and Periods

You will also see some other changes;

- Lessons start at 8.50am (apart from Wednesday for Pro-Jects and Electives).
- Monday and Tuesday you have 4 periods a day.
- Thursday and Friday you have 5 periods a day.
- Aronga is the new Kaitohutohu/Academic Mentoring program and occurs after Period 2.
- Whanau time is on a Tuesday.
- Assemblies will be on a Monday in Week 2, 6 and 10.
